Application for Membership

Participants' personal data:

When you book and attend an event, training course, etc.], we need to collect your personal information so that we can honour your booking and to enable you to participate in the [course, competition, event, etc.].

Why we need your personal information - legitimate purposes

We also process our members' personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests to:

- promote and encourage participation in golf by sending members' communications and booking information
 for upcoming competitions and events. Our competitions and events may be filmed or photographed and your
 personal information may also be used in images captured from our competitions and events, which we use
 for promotional, education and development purposes.
- we require to hold this information and ensure accuracy by accepting and managing entries for our
 competitions and checking your personal information to ensure you are entered into the correct category.
 Invite our members as award winners or guests to our annual awards dinner ceremony.
- respond to and communicate with members regarding your questions, comments, support needs or complaints, concerns or allegations in relation to golf or other events within our Club. We require to have a complaints and disciplinary procedure and will use your personal information to investigate your complaint, to suspend membership, take disciplinary action, etc.

Where we process your personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests, you have the right to object to us using your personal information for the above purposes. If you wish to object to any of the above processing, please contact us on [insert details]. If we agree and comply with your objection, this may affect our ability to undertake the tasks above for the benefit of you as a member⁴

Why we need your personal information - legal obligations

 The Companies Act 2006 / Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 to maintain a register of our members, which includes our members' name, address, the date they were admitted to membership and the date on which they ceased to be our member[, and hold general meetings, including issuing notices and voting errangements.
